The essential course materials for the CIBJO Academy are the various CIBJO Blue Books and and guides, relating to the entire spectrum of the gemstone and jewellery industries, covering natural diamonds, laboratory-grown diamonds, coloured gemstones, pearls, coral, precious metals, principles of responsible sourcing, the operation of gem laboratories, marketing, ethics and legal issues, and more.

One of the world's most respected gemmologists, over his 50-year career Mr. Scarratt has been the CEO of the Bahrain Institute of Pearls & Gemstones (DANAT), Managing Director for SE Asia for the Gemological Institute of America (GIA), Laboratory Director for the AGTA (American Gem Trade Association) Gemological Testing Center in New York, Director of AIGS (Asian Institute of Gemological Sciences) in Bangkok, Chief Executive and Laboratory Director GAGTL (Gemmological Association & Gem Testing Laboratory of Great Britain) in London, and Managing Partner at ICA|GemLab in Bangkok. He has published papers extensively in such journals as The Journal of Gemmology (UK), Gems and Gemology (USA) and many others. He co-authored the books "The Crown Jewels," and "The Pearl & the Dragon." He also is President of CIBJO's Sector A, which oversees all gem materials, President of the CIBJO Pearl Commission and Vice President of the organisation's Coral Commission.

"The CIBJO Academy was created to make accessible to the jewellery industry the massive body of work, including trade standards and principles, and harmonized terminology and nomenclature, which is produced, refined and updated on a constant basis by the various commissions and special committees operating under the umbrella of our World Jewellery Confederation," said CIBJO President Gaetano Cavalieri. "We are extremely fortunate to have a world-class expert of the calibre of Ken Scarratt heading the new body, and I strongly recommend that participants and visitor to the Bangkok Gems & Jewelry Fair take advantage of this special opportunity."
